- I. Meeting called to order at 5:30 pm.
- II. Roll call taken by Marci Jo.
- III. Starlight Parade: Rodney McCambridge, AFSCME Organizer is looking for help with the Starlight Parade being held on June 5. Help is still needed in the following areas:

IV. Treasurer's Report:

a. It was Moved by Theresia and seconded by Robert to approve the April treasurer's financial report (including the Balance Sheet Standard, Balance Sheet Detail, P&L Budget Performance, and the Transactions by Date) and file an audit. - f. Board Visioning Most people could not do a retreat in June. It will be moved it to September when most people are able to do it then.

- c. Bulletin Board (Donna) In Donna's search for bulletin boards, she has only found a few. She needs to get more put up. It was moved by Matt and seconded by Robert to allow up to \$2300 to help pay for supplies and copying expenses. **Motion Passed Unanimously. 050110**
